

Target

Technicians that have completed the 4100U-S1 Introduction course or those technicians that are familiar with the Simplex fire panel range now moving into a programming / commissioning role.

Comments

This course covers programming of the 4100U-S1 standalone fire panel, using multiple template files. Course includes 6 practical modules where attendees are required to program 6 different demonstration sites and verify the correct operation of all programmed hardware.

Outcomes

Attendees will be able to;

understand the 4100U programming software;

identify the correct sequence of programming;

modify template files;

make changes to programs without template change;

program additional hardware to demo site configurations;

understand the importance of correct template selection;

Assessment - theory and practical completion of module 4 minimum.

Pre-requisites

A component of this course is PC based and as such attendees **must be able** to open, save, copy, paste, rename, set-up directories and folders in a Windows operating system environment without assistance.

Attendees do require a PC equipped with two or more USB ports (can use parallel port for training) and a serial port (or USB serial adapter). Attendees should have appropriate **user access to permit software installation**.

It is expected that Simplex Fire Products will have assessed PC suitability and would have pre-loaded the 4100U programmer prior to the course start date. Contact your nearest Simplex office on 1300 552 559.

Attendees should also bring along a terminal screwdriver.

NOTE—successful completion of this course is required as a minimum to obtain a software licence agreement issued by Simplex for the 4100U programmer and attend further programming courses.
